**DAY-1(23.01.2012, Monday)**

The programme started at 9.00 a.m. with the registration followed by the hosting the YRC flag, singing the YRC song and taking the YRC pledge by the programme officers and YRC volunteers. This was followed by the inaugural function.

**Session II and III** was on **Leadership Training and Personality Development**. It was handled by **Mr. Rathna Natarajan**. Mrs. Nicey conducted the programme excellently and removed all wrong practices in First Aid. She spoke on basic life support techniques, ABC rules and CPR method for adult's children and infants. She show them how to handle the victims of electric stock, heart attack, swallowed poisons, inhalation of poisonous gas, managing the victims of fire, to the point she made the entire session interesting and interactive.

**Session IX** was about **Blood Donation** was taken by **Dr.T.M. Subbarao**. He detailed explain about different blood groups, the advantages of blood donation for the giver and the receiver and how blood donation is a life – saving act. He dispelled all our myths regarding blood donation and answer to all questions rose by the participant.

### **Day III (25.01.2012 Wednesday)**

**Session X** was about **Communication is an Art** was taken by **Dr. C. Suriyanarayan**. He was an embodiment of happiness, humour and joy. He also gave the lots quotes regarding the art of communication.

**Session XI** was on **Adolescent Psychology** was handled by **Dr. B. Selvaraj**. It was really a psychological session which explored the minds of adolescents. The distraction, the stress and the over – conscious behavior of the teens is dealt in detail by the speaker.
