BHARATHIAR UNIVERSITY FREE EDUCATION SCHEME

This scheme will be called as **Bharathiar University Free Education Scheme**. This Scheme is available for UG courses only in colleges and PG courses only in the University.

Government Colleges are exempted from the scheme.

Each college is required to offer a maximum of five UG seats a year to eligible poor students.

This scheme is applicable to the residents of Coimbatore, Nilgiris, Erode and Tirupur Districts.

The colleges will be allotted extra seats over and above the maximum limit to the extent they have made admission for poor students under this scheme.

ELIGIBILITY:

- (1) The annual income of the parents should be less than Rs.30,000/- p.a.
- (2) A poor student will be identified by the following criteria:
 - (a) orphans
 - (b) wards of coolies, agricultural/industrial and other manual labourers
 - (c) destitute
 - (d) widows
 - (e) dependents of the widows
 - (f) children of victims of natural calamities
 - (g) students working and studying
 - (h) dependent children of Leprosy Affected Persons (LAPs)
- (3) Students who have already paid the fees and joined in the college may be given less priority.
- (4) Students studied in corporation / municipal / government schools getting scholarships will be given priority.
- (5) After identifying the poor students by the above criteria, marks in their qualifying examinations may be taken as the basis for selecting the beneficiaries under the scheme.
- (6) The college concerned shall meet out all the expenses of such poor beneficiaries like tuition fee, boarding and lodging.

(7) Wherever possible preference be given for the single girl student.

MODE OF SELECTION:

The beneficiaries be ranked by the following criteria irrespective of the community.

The eligible candidates be called for interactive counseling district wise.

The candidates be allotted as far as possible to the nearest college and allotted to the courses of their choice.

The candidates be asked to bring the following certificates.

1. Higher Secondary Marks Statement / Consolidated Marks statement for PG admission.
2. Transfer Certificate
3. Proof of First generation candidate
4. Proofs as to orphans / Wards of Coolies, labourers / destitutes / widows / dependents of the widows / wards of parents below the poverty line.
5. Victims of natural calamities
6. Students working and Studying
7. Nativity Certificate
8. Declaration as to non-ownership of house or land

2011-12 – sending of – reg.

I am, by direction, sending herewith a specimen copy of the proforma for 20% additional seats for the academic year 2011- 12. The duly filled in proforma may be sent to this office on or before 30.06.2011, to enable this office to proceed further. It is also informed that the Colleges, who have already requested for additional seats for the academic year 2011-12, need not apply.

The Principals are requested not to apply for additional seats before obtaining affiliation from the University for the respective courses for the academic year 2011-12 and without having filling up of all the seats, as per sanctioned strength. The Guidelines for additional seats are given hereunder.

1. The 20% additional seats shall be worked out on the sanctioned strength permitted to the particular course in the college.
2. The total of the sanctioned strength plus 20% additional seats shall not exceed the maximum strength permitted by this University.
3. 20% additional seats shall not be sanctioned for UG and PG courses started during the academic year 2011-12.
4. If the colleges have already obtained the maximum sanctioned strength, request for 20% additional seats in that course will not be entertained.

Sub: B.U.- Affiliated Colleges – Proforma for 10% Additional seats for
2011-12 – sending of – reg.

I am, by direction, inform that the colleges situated in rural and hill areas of Bharathiar University jurisdiction, are eligible to apply for 10% additional seats for the academic year 2011-12. The proforma for applying 10% additional seats is enclosed herewith. The completed proforma may be sent to this office on or before 30.06.2011 along with the evidence that the college is situated out of the city/corporation limit (a certificate from the concerned VAO) to enable this office to proceed further.

The Principals are requested not to apply for 10% additional seats before obtaining affiliation from the University for the respective courses for 2011-12 and without filling up of all the seats, as per sanctioned strength and 20% additional seats. The Guidelines for obtaining 10% additional seats are given hereunder.

1. The College should be situated in the rural areas located in Village Panchayat and in the hill areas.
2. The 10% of additional seats may be over and above the maximum strength sanctioned.
