- The placement cells of the affiliated colleges were strengthened by organizing Orientation Programmes for the placement officers of the colleges at the University level.
- Along with the revision of syllabus, the members of faculty were oriented to teach the updated content of the syllabi.
- The “**greenboxbu. yahoo.co.in**” the website was created for student feedback and grievance Redressal. **75** representations were received and grievances were addressed.
