GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Application forms to register for the ensuring first semester examinations to be held during January 2010 for the various courses (UG/PG/MCA/MBA/Diploma/PG Diploma) Offered in partner Institutions as Participatory Programmes are available in the University website and have also been sent by e-mail to all Partner Institutions.
2. The application forms shall be downloaded and distributed to students as soft copies or hard copies. The filled in hard copies of the application form as per the instructions given in the application shall be sent back to the Controller of Examinations on or before the last date stipulated.
LAST DATE FOR RECEIPT OF FILLED-IN APPLICATION WITHOUT FINE : 24.12.2009.
LAST DATE FOR RECEIPT OF FILLED-IN APPLICATION WITH FINE of Rs.100 : 31.12.2009
3. Computer generated applications in report of candidates appearing for the third semester examinations will be sent by post. The same shall be distributed to the candidates concerned. The details required shall be filled up and the completed application in all respect shall be returned to the Controller of Examinations. The examination fee and other fees as given in the table shall be collected from the students in accordance with the number of papers for which they register for the examination and sent in the form of a **Demand Draft drawn in favour of the Registrar, Bharathiar University, Payable at Coimbatore.** The Demand Draft shall be accompanied with the details of names of students admission year and semester wise and the details of fees paid by each student. Candidates who have completed the duration of the programme but with arrears are considered as private candidates. However, the partner institutions are requested to inform the students with arrear paper to submit the application to the institution. The candidates should appear for the arrear examinations in the partner institutions, if it is an examination centre or in a centre where they had appeared for the regular examination or in any other examination centre as informed subsequently.
4. Practical examination: Practical examinations will be conducted at the respective centres after the completion of the theory examinations. Practical examination centre shall be the same institution where the candidate has attended his / her practical classes.

Candidate who is eligible to appear for the semester / annual examination for the FIRST TIME shall submit the examination application and pay the fee for all the subjects of that semester / examination, whether the candidate is willing/ not willing to appear for that examination and allot the continuous register number. Any candidate failing to do so and apply for the next semester examinations shall have to pay
 - i. The fee that he / she should have paid for the previous examination as if he / she had applied for that examination and
 - ii. The fee for all regular subjects of the current examination.

8. Candidates who desire to apply for Retotalling (All Course except Diploma) and Revaluation (UG Courses only) shall apply for the same within fifteen days from the date of publication of results in websites.
